





#### **Recipe of the Month**

#### MEATBALL LASAGNA

#### INGREDIENTS

- 1 lb. ground beef
- 1 lb. ground pork sausage
- · 1 lb. ground veal
- · 4 tsp. Italian seasoning, divided
- 2 large eggs
- 3/4 c. breadcrumbs
- Kosher salt
- · Freshly ground black pepper
- · 2 tbsp. extra-virgin olive oil
- 21/2 c. ricotta cheese
- 1 (24-oz.) jar marinara
- · 3 tbsp. unsalted butter
- 12 oz. dry lasagna noodles
- 1 1/2 lb. shredded mozzarella
- 1/4 c. grated Parmesan

#### INSTRUCTIONS

- 1.In large bowl, combine ground beef, pork sausage, and veal. Season with 2 teaspoons Italian seasoning. Add eggs and breadcrumbs and season with salt and pepper, then mix until incorporated. Form into 1 %-inch balls
- 2. Heat oil in a skillet over medium-high and fry the meatballs, working in 2 batches, until lightly browned all over, about 4 minutes per side. Set aside and let cool.
- 3. Transfer cooled meatballs to a new bowl and mash them up with a fork.

  Add ricotta to the bowl and mix to combine.
- 4. In the same skillet over medium heat, add marinara and butter. Season with salt, pepper, and remaining Italian seasoning, and heat until warmed through.
- 5.In a large baking pan, add a layer of sauce, followed by the ricotta mixture, followed by a layer of mozzarella. Add a layer of lasagna noodles. Repeat layers two more times. Top with a generous layer of mozzarella and parmesan.
- 6. Cover with foil and Bake at 350° for 50 minutes, then remove foil and bake 10 minutes more. Let cool 15 minutes before serving.
